The 2016 Operating Revenues are \$1,343,315 compared to \$1,316,517 in 2015 an increase of \$26,798. The increase in expenditures is caused by the net effect of a decrease in administrative expenses and an increase in LOSAP based on Advisor estimate increase and in members.

Amount to be raised by taxation in 2016 is \$1,121,715 compared to 2015 of \$1,109,489. The tax rate in 2016 is .0429 (4.29¢) per \$100 assessed valuation vs. .042 (4.2¢) per \$100 assessed valuation in 2015. Unrestricted surplus utilized in 2016 of \$221,600 is \$21 less than in 2015.

The Fire District's 2016 amount to be raised by taxation is in compliance with existing Property Tax Levy Cap.

The Amount of \$200,000 is being appropriated to the reserve for future capital outlays. There is no debt service in the budget this year. An Average residential unit with an assessed valuation of \$383,000 will pay a fire tax of \$164.31 in 2016 compared to \$160.86 in 2015, an increase of \$3.45.
